

ODA Service Date Bulletin

As of May 10, 2005

The EDI 837 Claim allows for two different date formats to be entered for service date. A service date qualifier of “D8” indicates a single date format, CCYYMMDD, and a date qualifier of “RD8” indicates a range date format, Begin Date (CCYYMMDD) – End Date (CCYYMMDD). A date range format may contain a single date by setting begin and end dates to the same value.

Service date options for PIMS are identified by funding source in the table below.

Funding Source	D8 Option	RD8 Option	Comments
PASSPORT	Yes	Yes	D8 – Enter date of service RD8 – Begin & End date must be the same
Choices	Yes	Yes	D8 – Enter date of service RD8 – Begin & End date must be the same
PACE	No	Yes	RD8 – Begin date is first of month End date is last day of month
CCP	Yes	Yes	D8 – Enter date of service RD8 – Begin & End date must be the same

Examples:

Service date is located in loop 2400 – Service Line and is identified as a service date by the 472 code in the Time/Date Qualifier (DTP02) of the DTP segment.

- 1) Example of a single date of service using both the D8 and RD8 qualifiers.

DTP*472*D8*20050510~

DTP*472*RD8*20050510-20050510~

- 2) Example of a PACE service date for month of May 2005.

DTP*472*RD8*20050501-20050531~
