If you have conducted research or created an artistic work in an aging related area, you are invited to submit an application to present at a *Modern AGE-ucation* event. If selected as a speaker or artist, you will gain visibility in the aging network, help shape the direction of aging research and policy in Ohio, and meet policymakers in your area of interest.

Evaluation and Scheduling

Members of the *Modern AGE-ucation* Steering Committee evaluate all proposed presentations based upon the following criteria: overall quality, relevance to aging network, and timeliness of the topic. All applicants will be notified of the committee's decision. Interested applicants are encouraged to apply throughout the year, as educational events will be scheduled continuously.

Presentation Guidelines

Presentations should last one hour, including a brief session for questions and answers. Programs should consist of one or two student presenters and one faculty sponsor.

Speaker Expenses

Modern AGE-ucation events are made available to the aging network through webinar. Travel expenses, including gas, parking and hotel fees, will not be paid by ODA. If needed and appropriate, the *Modern AGE-ucation* Steering Committee will work with presenters who would like to utilize distance options, such as webinar, teleconference and videoconference.
